CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury, complains and says that on or about 7/11/2018 1:05:00 AM, in the County of Bernalillo, State of New Mexico, the above-named defendant(s) did commit the above Offense(s) (here state the essential facts):

On 07/11/2018, at approximately 0035 hours, I arrived in the area of 1750 Indian School NW, to assist APD on a DWI investigation. APD they received a call for service and located the driver of the vehicle who displayed outward signs of intoxication. I made contact with the driver (later identified as [redacted]). As I spoke with [redacted] I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath and I could see that [redacted] eyes were blood shot and watery. I also observed that [redacted] speech was slurred. I asked [redacted] if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages to which [redacted] replied he had had seven beers. I asked [redacted] if he would conduct standardized field sobriety test which [redacted] agreed to take. On a smooth, level, and well lit surface, free of any debris, I conducted standardized tests in which [redacted] performed poorly. [redacted] was placed under arrest for DWI and read the New Mexico Implied Consent Advisory to which [redacted] agreed to be tested. The result of the breath alcohol test were greater than .16g per 210 liters of breath.

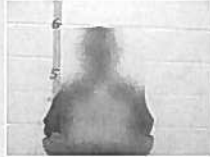

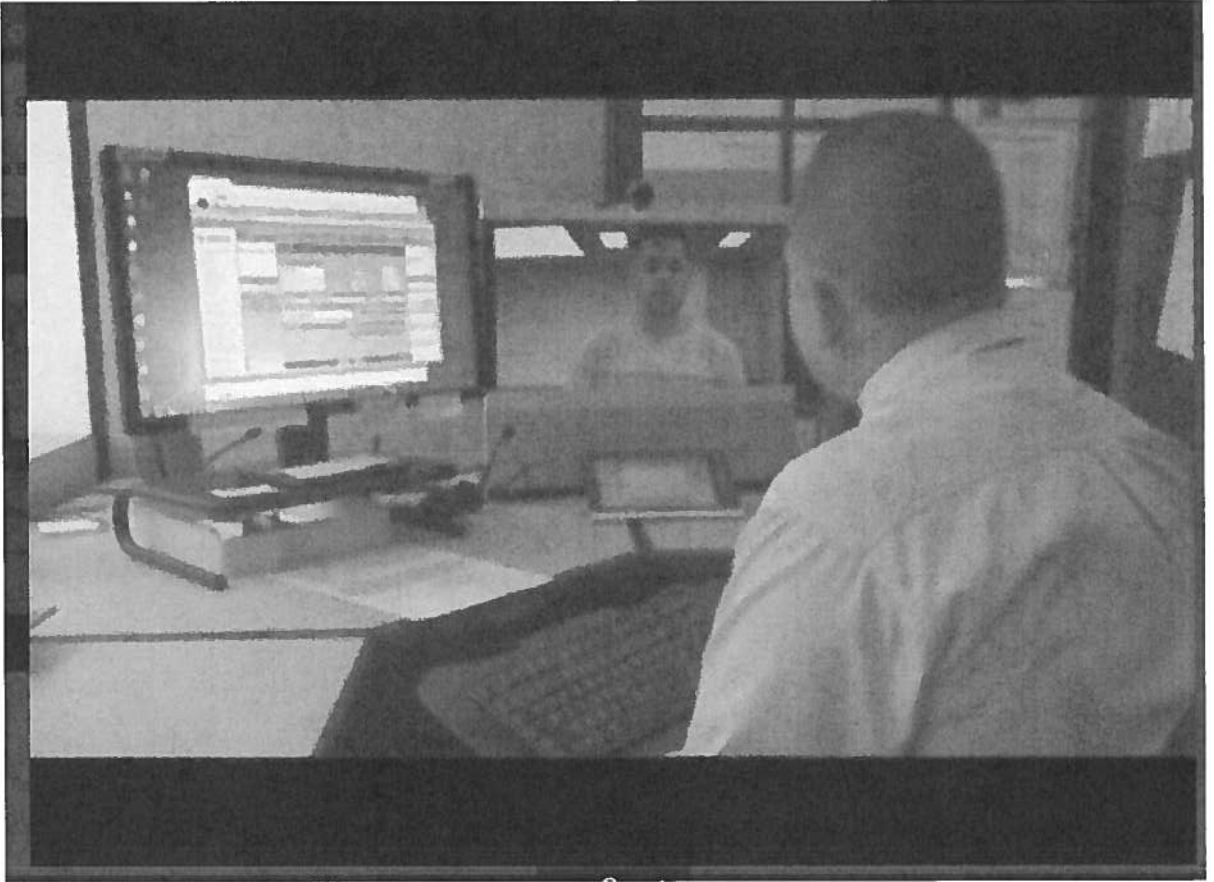

6. Determine if defendant qualifies for release based on charges and complete criminal history investigation. The Intake Officer has authority to release misdemeanor charges and non-violent 3rd and 4th degree felony charges.
7. If the defendant has an extensive criminal history, failure to appear history, a criminal case pending adjudication, currently on probation or parole, has a history of similar charges, or active warrant, the defendant will not be interviewed for release on own recognizance. Intake Officer will email the detention center email group stating the defendant will not be released on own recognizance by Intake staff.
8. If it is determined the defendant should be interviewed for consideration of release by Intake staff, an email will be sent to the detention group email and or a phone call stating the defendant needs to be brought to the monitor for an interview.

9. Defendant will be brought to the arraignment monitor by detention staff.



10. The Intake Officer will interview the defendant utilizing the interview below.

11. If the defendant does not have strong community ties (living in New Mexico for at least six months) or Intake Officer is unable to successfully verify where they live and work, the detention center will be contacted via email and informed the defendant will not be released by Intake staff.
12. If the defendant has strong community ties, for example: living in New Mexico for at least six months, military, contact phone number, stable address, employment history and community ties have been verified, the ROR process will continue.

13. The Intake Officer will then initiate the case in Odyssey. The main charges will be initiated only (for example, only a DWI charge will be initiated), if there are citations, the Magistrate Court will need to add these to the case at a later date.
14. The Intake Officer will set an arraignment date in Odyssey for the defendant. The Intake Officer will verbally go over the court date with the defendant.

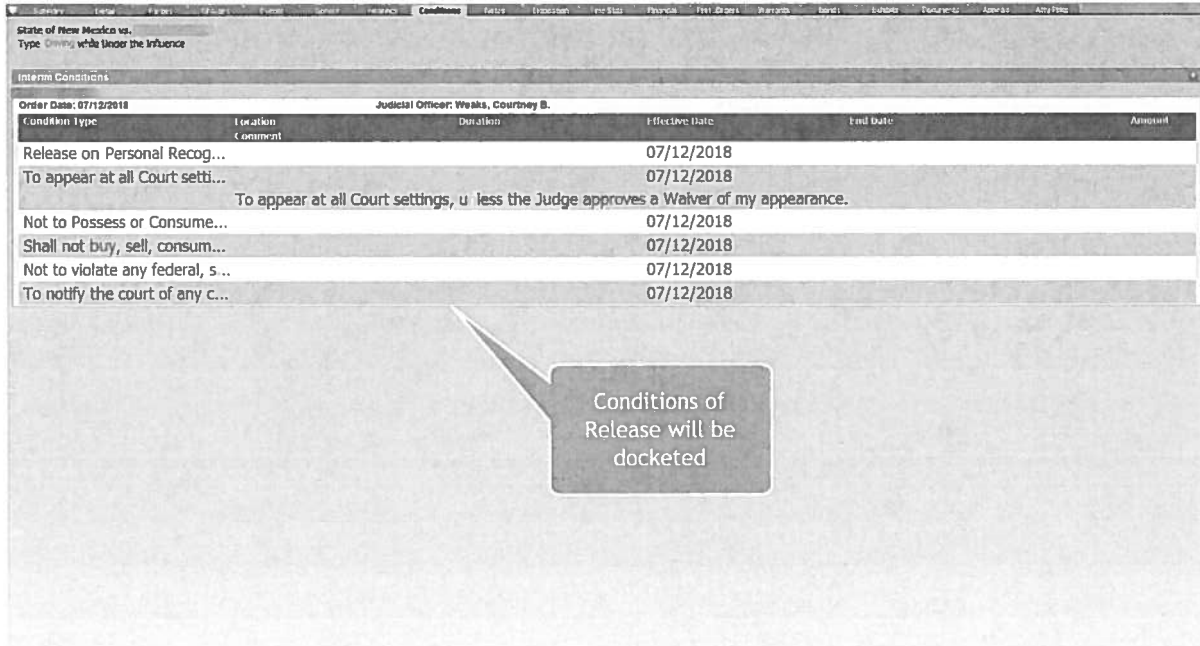
