IP Based

IP Based - share an ISDN bridge with state if needed.

IP over Local Network to County Network

LAN Connection, Conferencing is between Judges

Point to point IP based

some local courts use ISDN to their jails, but we are replacing with IP address

Subscribe to an Internet based video conference system

Two T1 data circuits are combined in a point-to-point network, and are shared by four courtrooms. Digital calls are established by using programmed buttons on a control pad to call the assigned IP address.

We have used most the the technology listed above, starting with analog units powered through codecs, pc's, with special software to the current use of digital polycoms
