


Limitations

- 1. It is only a chatbot (and it might get things wrong).
- 2. It returns long-form, written text.
- 3. It is unsecure.
- 4. It only returns one answer at a time.
- 5. It is not integrated with anything else.

What if we asked GPT to return structured data?
