

How are video conference proceedings recorded? (Other responses)

A digital record is made using the same equipment and procedures as with any other hearing.

A digital, audio recording is made

Audio recording (3)

audio only is recorded through FTR Gold the same as any other court hearing.

Court Reporter

court reporter and/or court minutes

Court reporters capture the record as if all in same court facility

In a video court (trial record made on video) audio & video is preserved. In an audio court just the audio is recorded.

In misdemeanor cases (bond hearings) no record is made of the proceedings. In felony case arraignments the record is preserved by a court reporter, no other record is made.

integrated with DCR AV or audio only if no central DCR

Not a court of record but audio and video files retained and audio files published on website

Not done in Franklin County

Record is made by a court reporter but video can be recorded if requested by the judge.

some of the proceedings are recorded and preserved for a limited period of time (120 days); other hearings are not recorded

voice recording whihc is the same as any other hearing

We only use for meetings with other state agencies

Whatever is required for the particular hearing, some have no recording, others live court reporter, others sound recording - video is

NOT the official record
