


HOW TO SIGN UP FOR FACEBOOK

1. Open up your internet browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox, Google Chrome, Safari, etc.).
2. Insert <http://www.facebook.com> into the web address bar.



3. The page will ask you to sign up. Insert your first name, last name, email (twice), preferred password, birthday and gender.
4. Click the SIGN UP button.

5. Once you sign in (and as long as all of your information is complete and correct), you will be brought to a new webpage: "Step 1: Find your friends." It asks, "Are you friends already on Facebook?" Facebook will search your email's address book for friends who already have a Facebook account.

6. Choose the email service (Gmail, Hotmail, Yahoo, other) you want Facebook to search and insert your email.

7. You can choose to skip this step, but it will be more difficult to find friends that way.
8. Insert your email and then click the FIND FRIENDS button.
9. A pop up will appear in a separate email. This asks you to allow Facebook to search your email for Facebook users.
10. COME BACK TO THIS
11. Now you move to "Step 2: Profile Information." It asks you to complete your high school, college/university and employer.

12. You can choose to fill in this information or skip this step. Filling in this information will allow you to find friends/co-workers/family more quickly.



16. After you have scrolled through the list of suggestions, click on the “Save and Continue” button.




17. Now it will take you to “Step 3: Profile Picture.” This is a photo that appears as a thumbnail on the main Facebook page. People usually select a headshot of themselves. Others pick photos of their children or celebrities.

18. To upload a photo, click “Upload a Photo.”



 Profile pictures and cover photos are public. You can control the audience for other photos you upload to Facebook.


19. Click on the “Browse” button and find the photo you want to use.



20. Click “Open.”

21. Then click “Save and Continue.”

22. Once you’ve completed all three steps, Facebook will welcome you!
