The selected professional will be responsible for leading all aspects of the court's technology use and operations. The position will serve at the director level on the executive management team, directly reporting to the Trial Court Administrator while working with the Chief Judge and Trial Court Administrator to establish short and long-term technology goals and objectives. The role will provide input on the organization's strategic planning as it relates to use of technology, establish departmental policies and protocols, oversee and ensure the security of all networks and systems while supervising a progressive team of IT and AV professionals. The CIO will also prepare and manage budgets, attend state and national seminars and will be expected to represent the circuit at state-wide technology meetings and serve on statewide committees as assigned.

The selected candidate will have impeccable IT knowledge and technical skills to include outstanding analytical and troubleshooting skills. The ideal candidate will have a solid understanding of data management, insight into network security trends, knowledge of emerging technologies, and a firm understanding of IT best practices. The candidate will also have excellent management skills and an ability to network and build relationships with vendors, staff and leadership.
