

Court Technology Framework – Priorities for 2011 - Draft

CTF priorities from JTC meeting held December 1, 2010 (presented in sequence they were discussed):

1. Pilot projects

- Should not be framed as pilots for the framework
- Should be framed as pilots for how to use the framework to help:
 - achieve project success
 - enhance outcomes
 - reduce risk

2. Strategic planning

- Courts need help with whole idea of strategic planning (not very many do it well)
- This should also include helping them figure out how to use the CTF in their strategic planning – perhaps as a subset of the High-Performance Courts framework (HPCF)
- Consider a 2-day boot camp for courts serious about using the framework (including the HPCF, the CTF, and "CTF profiles" - see below)

3. Profiles

- To organize best practices for a particular problem or area of concern
- Examples already in progress:
 - E-filing
 - COOP
- Maybe also:
 - CDL
 - ...
- Include a repository
 - Store profiles and other CTF materials that anyone can access and download
 - Maybe just another page on the CTF wiki for now
 - May eventually want a more robust and searchable tool
- Includes different “views” of a profile:
 - Mind map
 - Spreadsheet
 - Drill-down to details of a profile via links from the CTF graphic

4. Outreach

- Education/sessions at conferences
- Improving documentation
- Writing articles

5. JTC products

- Map JTC products to the CTF
- Identify gaps
- Determine possible new JTC products
