A Resource from the Pandemic Rapid Response Team

(updated December 2023)

In the summer of 2020, the Conference of Chief Justices and Conference of State Court Administrators passed a **resolution** "In Support of the Guiding Principles for Post-Pandemic Court Technology" which called for courts "to adopt a remote-first or remote-friendly approach[] when moving court processes forward."

This resource and accompanying table (Appendix 1) offer an update on how the 50 states and the District of Columbia have approached allowing for remote or virtual proceedings in some way.

These materials are an update to the Rapid Response Team's September 2021 National Scan of Remote-First and Remote-Friendly Court Rules.

Methodology

From the **Appendix 1** table, readers will quickly notice how the authorizing authority and procedures vary a lot: state court rule, local court rule or order, administrative order, chief justice orders or directives, supreme court policy, or state law. Some approaches are comprehensive. Others are minimal.

Because jurisdictions often use vastly different terms when referring to remote-related matters, **Appendix 2** is a list of keywords and phrases that may help future researchers.

Concluded task forces

Some states are working from *completed* task force reports or meeting materials, like:

Continuing workgroups

Other states have groups that are still working.

Vermont's special advisory committee, for example, submitted court rule changes for public comment in mid-2023. The special advisory committee most recently met on **December 5, 2023**.

lowa started its group on February 20, 2023.

Illinois continues to identify best practices.

Nevada's Commission to Study Best Practices for Virtual Advocacy last met on September 26, 2023.

Proposed court rules or state laws are actively "in process" in some jurisdictions

Rule, statute, and other policy-making authority continue to be developed in other places. By non-exhaustive example:

Vermont's Advisory Committee on Rules for Family Proceedings met on July 21, 2023 to consider draft rule amendments related to remote participation in family proceedings as proposed to the Supreme Court's Special Advisory Committee on Remote Access.

Colorado adopted a law about remote participation in residential evictions that will go into effect on January 1, 2024 unless a referendum petition is filed. Colorado adopted a different law about remote public access to criminal court proceedings that will go into effect on September 1, 2023 unless a referendum petition is filed.











Local court rules and processes

Other jurisdictions defer to local courts to decide how to handle remote hearings (sometimes within defined guardrails). Non-exhaustive examples include:

Nebraska state law allows that "All non-evidentiary hearings, and any evidentiary hearings approved by the district court and by stipulation of all parties that have filed an appearance, may be heard by the court telephonically or by videoconferencing or similar equipment at any location within the judicial district as ordered by the court and in a manner that ensures the preservation of an accurate record. Such hearings shall not include trials before a jury. Hearings conducted in this manner shall be consistent with the public's access to the courts." Neb. Rev. Stat. § 24-303(2). Companion local court rules for remote hearings are available online.

North Carolina's General Assembly (through June 18, 2021-approved language) authorized judicial officials to "conduct proceedings of all types using an audio and video transmission in which the parties, the presiding official, and any other participants can see and hear each other. Judicial officials conducting proceedings by audio and video transmission under this section must safeguard the constitutional rights of those persons involved in the proceeding and preserve the integrity of the judicial process." GA § 7A-49.6.

North Dakota's Supreme Court adopted Administrative Rule 52 (effective December 1, 2022) which "provides a framework for the use of reliable electronic means for proceedings in North Dakota's district and municipal courts."

Oregon's Chief Justice issued an eight-page Order No. 22-012 on June 23, 2022 permitting remote proceedings. Local courts have adopted related remote appearance local court rules.

Statewide virtual directories

Some states host a statewide virtual directory web page from where local court sessions can be accessed for online viewing (Alaska, Indiana, Michigan, New Jersey, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Utah, Wisconsin, and Wyoming).
