### Sight Translation 1: English to Foreign Language

On Tuesday, July 27, 2020, at approximately **12:00 p.m.**<sup>1</sup>, a Riverdale city employee went to the police station to notify officers that he **had located**<sup>2</sup> several laptop computers on a **bench**<sup>3</sup> in Balboa Park. Police officers initiated an investigation **into**<sup>4</sup> the incident. The officers determined that the laptops **were taken**<sup>5</sup> from a nearby school, located on the 3800 block of Balboa Street. Officers responded to the school and found signs of forced entry.

A school **representative**<sup>6</sup> met with officers at **the scene**<sup>7</sup>. Upon conducting a **walkthrough**<sup>8</sup> of the school, the representative informed officers that several more computers were **missing**<sup>9</sup>. Officers contacted the Burglary Detective, who **took over**<sup>10</sup> the investigation.

On July 29, a patrol officer **noticed**<sup>11</sup> that an individual he had arrested on an **out-of-county**<sup>12</sup> warrant had laptops in his vehicle that **resembled**<sup>13</sup> the ones depicted in the **alert bulletin**<sup>14</sup>. He notified the burglary detective, who pursued this **lead**<sup>15</sup>.during **the course**<sup>16</sup> of his investigation.

The detective identified **23-year-old**<sup>17</sup> Justin Robles as the suspect in a series of burglaries in **the vicinity**<sup>18</sup> of Riverdale. A detective obtained **warrants**<sup>19</sup> for Robles' arrest, for the charges of **burglary**<sup>20</sup> and **grand theft**<sup>21</sup>. Robles, who was in custody on the **unrelated**<sup>22</sup> matter, was arrested on these warrants and **is awaiting**<sup>23</sup> transfer to the Riverdale County **jail**<sup>24</sup>. In addition to the July 27 school burglary, investigators developed **probable cause**<sup>25</sup> to arrest the suspect for four other burglaries.
